

This event is proudly presented by the Friends of the Library, whose support through memberships, book sales and the Chandler Booktique helps bring bestselling authors to our community.




## **Exhibit reveals the art of tattooing**

While tattooing equipment and trends change, tattoo artists and their relationships to clients remain a constant. Finished tattoos showcase the artistic expression and skill of the artist combined with the client's vision.


precess, answer questions and sign books.


