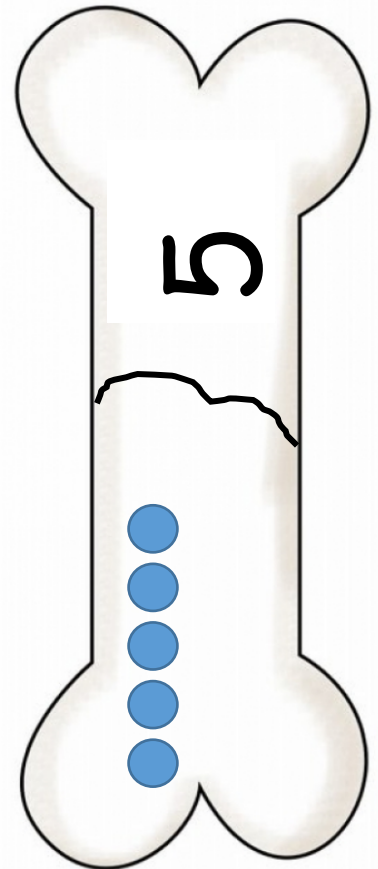
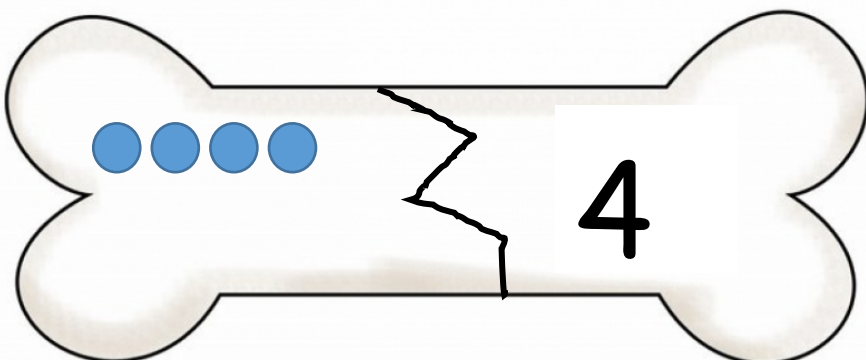
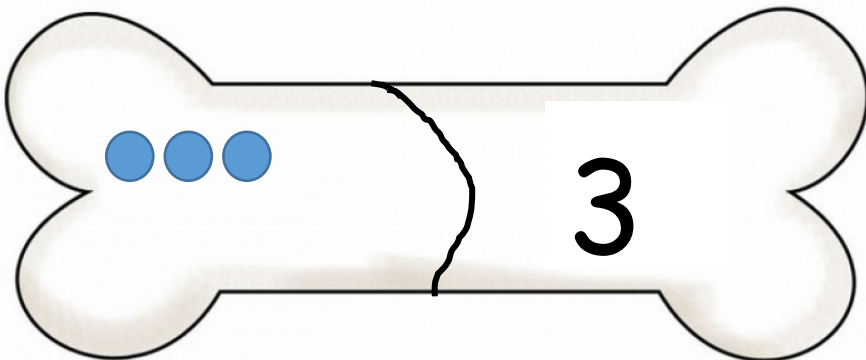
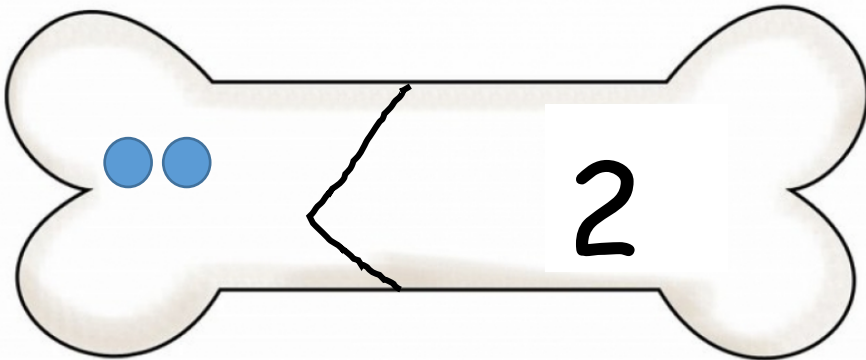
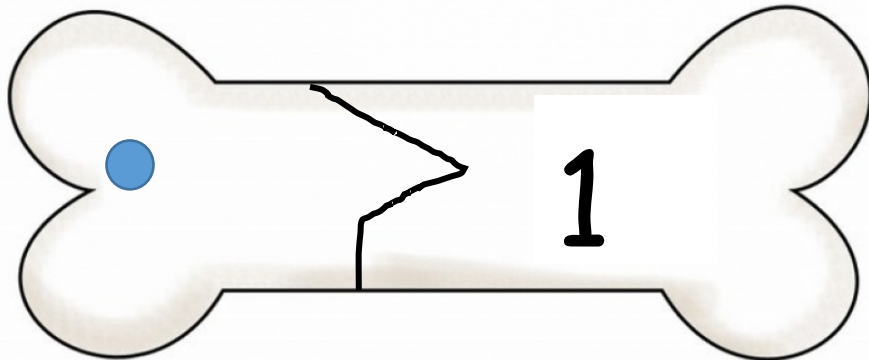


Dog Bone Number Matching Game

Print the dog bones and cut out to create a matching game.

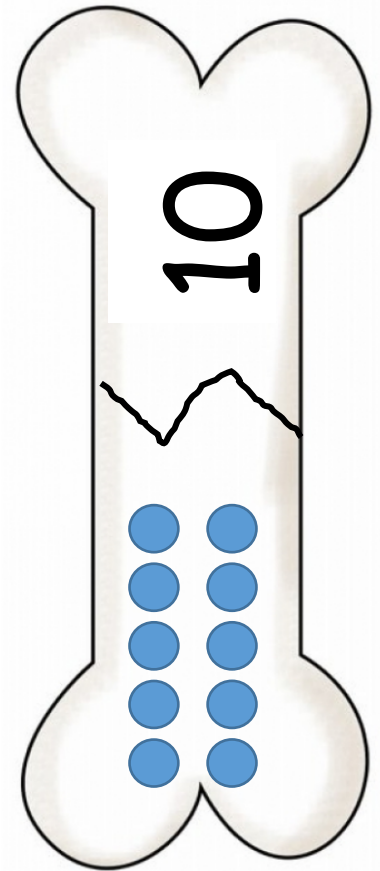
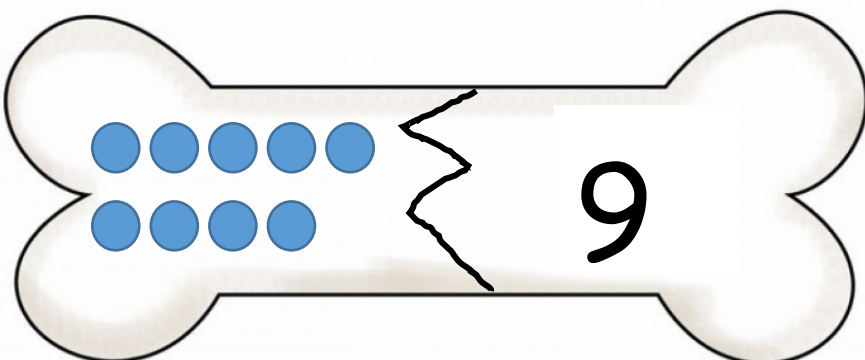
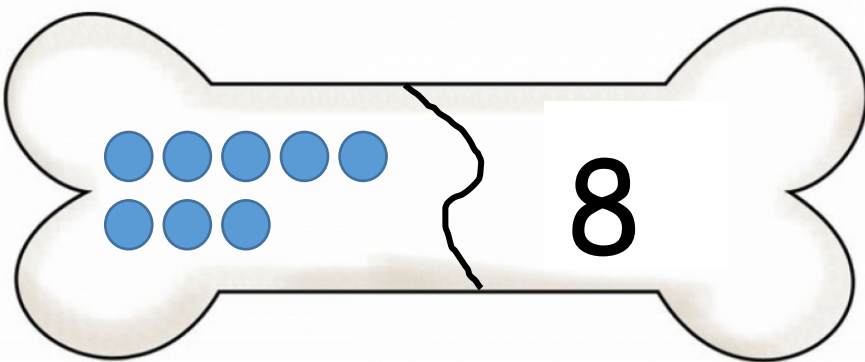
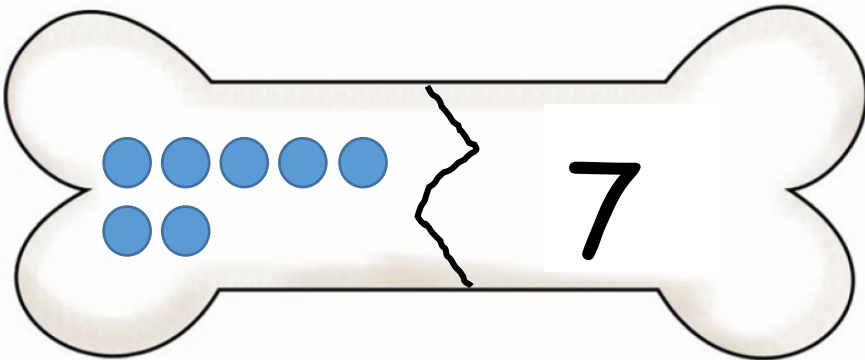
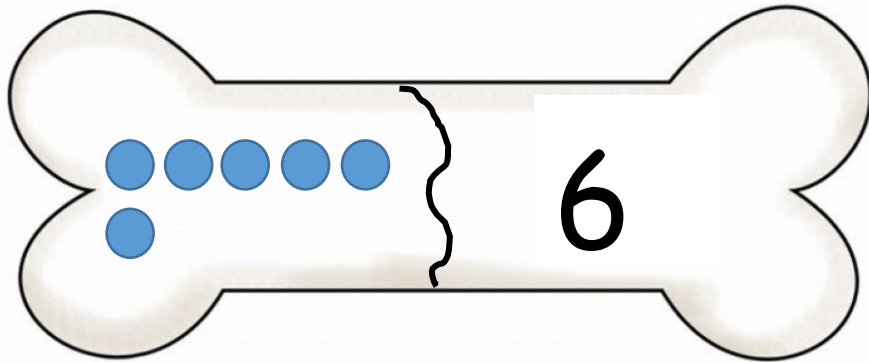


Teaching Tip:
